Confirmation of a booking at Leith Depot means that you agree with the terms and conditions set out below.

GENERAL DETAILS

- Venue standing capacity is 65 people (seating & tables also available).
- Venue rowed seating available at a capacity of 54 people.
- Our preference is a maximum of 2 acts on the bill. If you are considering more, please let us know if advance.
- Those performing on the night are entitled to a 10% discount off our food menu.
- Riders must be agreed & organised in advance of the event. If you are bringing your own rider this must be handed to bar staff who will dispense to artists.
- Small bar available in situ.
- We can provide catering for private events. Please provide details of requirements e.g., dietary needs, buffet, soup & sandwiches etc.
- Children are allowed at private functions until 9pm & need to be supervised at all times.

The entire premises is also available for hire: bar, restaurant & venue (total capacity 100). Please contact depotvenue@gmail.com for further details.

HIRE

The venue is available for private functions & events which do <u>not</u> require an engineer for free or at a small negotiable rate, depending on the type of event. **NOTE**: If you do <u>not</u> book an engineer you can use our small on stage mixer, and you will need to supply your own mics and leads.

We highly recommend using our in-house engineer.

Gig bookings has a **flat fee of £120 to be paid in advance.** The flat fee includes in house sound engineer, but <u>not</u> door person. If you don't have anyone to work the door, we may be able to provide at a **cost to you of £30**.

TICKETING

100% of ticket sales are for the artist, we don't take any fees from ticket sales.

You have the option to administer & manage your own online ticket sales for your event or we are happy to set this up for you. Ticket sales can also be on the door on the night (we can provide a cash box & float).

Please provide someone to work the door for you. Clicker & hand stamp required for all events which we will provide.

CANCELLATIONS

We require 28 days notice for cancellations. If you need to cancel your event, where the engineer has been booked in advance, you may be required to pay their fee regardless.

PROMOTION

Please supply us with an event Facebook page & a promo picture so we can help promote your event in our monthly 'what's on' line up, website listings, & our social media pages etc.

If you wish to be added to our monthly poster and online listings, details must be sent **6 weeks prior to the event**, if not, we can't guarantee your event will be featured.

SOUND CHECK TIMES

From **5:15pm sharp.** If this runs late for whatever reason this may result in a line check only.

LOAD-IN/LOAD OUT

Use 142 Venue front door entrance only. We stick to a **load in time of 4:45pm,** & **DOORS AT 7:00pm** (unless otherwise agreed). Live music curfew is 10:30pm but the venue can stay open until 12:30am.

ACCESSIBILITY

Accessible unisex toilet available in venue. Moveable ramp(s) available for main entrance, venue door and stage access. Patrons can contact us in advance to request seating & or advise of specific requirements. We also offer free gig tickets for carers, please contact us directly for more details.

DIGNITY AT WORK

We expect a positive & safe environment for our team, artists and customers. We have a zero tolerance to any sexist, racist, transphobic, homophobic or otherwise aggressive or intimidating behaviour. If anyone cannot adhere to this on the night, they will be refused entry.

Acts on stage that are deemed to be offensive will be shut down, at no cost to the venue.

DAYTIME USE

Daytime use and matinee shows is available at our venue, however, on occasion quick access from our team may be necessary, please accommodate any requests made for access.

STORING EQUIPMENT

If you wish to leave equipment to collect the next day then it must be picked up before the next day's load in. Any equipment left behind is at your own risk.

FIRE EXITS

Main door of bar and restaurant

Double doors via access to venue

Smoke machines are <u>not</u> allowed in the venue, they can trigger our smoke alarms.

PARKING

There is no parking available outside the premises. A loading bay is located directly opposite the building. **Please do not park on the pathways.**

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Tram stop available at the Foot of the Walk & or at Balfour street. Bus stop directly outside the building on Leith Walk.

- 2 x Yamaha DXR15 Tops & 1 x 12" Alto powered Sub
- House drum kit, shells & stands only (Breakables, Kick Pedal & Clutch supplied by artist)
- Marshal Bass Cab & Ampeg Bass Head, 2 x Guitars Amps (1 x Fender & 1 x Peavey)
- Mic stands & microphones (3-4 available)
- 2 powered floor monitors
- Projector & Screen
- Upright Piano
- Stage Area = 2m wide x 4m length
